There has been no new public health insecticide for over 30 years and these compounds will form the basis of a whole new generation of insecticides, safe for people and the environment. At last we will be able to seriously challenge insecticide resistance so that it is no longer a threat.

These new insecticides will form a protective shield around vulnerable populations as new drugs, vaccines and diagnostics do their work. Together we can eradicate the scourge of malaria once and for all. That's our vision. Nothing else will suffice.
